Acrylics with Alice

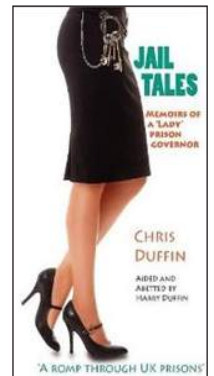
